Get ready to make a delicious creation inspired by artists such as Wayne Thiebaud and Lisa Milroy who make fantastic food paintings that are good enough to eat. Come and create your own delicious still life - and try to resist eating it long enough - to work from observation on an original canvas. On this one day workshop children will learn about coloured shadows and complimentary colour mixing and develop their painting techniques, whilst getting a taste of working on canvas like a real artist and adding finishing touches - the icing on the cake.




